

Basic Baby Hat – 1 yr



This pattern makes a hat that fits 45-50cm circumference and 17cm long.

You will need: 2 x 4mm straight needles, 2 x 3.25 dpns, yarn needle, Hayfield Bonus DK Green (less than 1/2), small amounts of black, white & red

Gauge: 5cm x 5cm = 10 st x 22 rows

c/o 70 on 4mm needles

Knit (garter st) until piece measures 13cm

Decrease:

1) *K8, K2tog (rep from * to end)

2 & all evens) K

3) *K2tog, K7 (rep from * to end)

5) *K6, K2tog (rep from * to end)

7) *K2tog, K5 (rep from * to end)

9) *K4, K2tog (rep from * to end)

11) *K2tog, K3 (rep from * to end)

13) *K2, K2tog (rep from * to end)

15) *K2tog, K1 (rep from * to end)

Thread yarn through remaining stitches and sew up the hat
